LAND:

Additional land area should be provided as per AICTE norms for the said course(s) to establish the facilities of academic/administrative amenities requirement. The confirmation of providing additional area to meet the minimum land requirement of AICTE norms should be made within 6 months.

BUILDING:

The building layout such as classrooms, laboratories, workshop is of inadequate size and area. The overall area of the internal space for above should be modified and expanded to provide adequate laboratories and classrooms as per AICTE norms.

The building classrooms/laboratories/workshop should be provided with adequate ventilation and lighting for conducive working.

The general up-keeping of the building and interval environment requires Modification / renovation / alteration to provide conducive working environment. As such, modification should be made to provide adequate moving space, Ventilation, lighting etc., as required for such professional courses.

FACULTY:

The total teaching faculty ratio with respect to various levels of faculty such as Professors, Asst. Professors, Lecturers should be as per the minimum norms of the AICTE and pay inadequacies should be made-up immediately in all the course(s)/disciplines and confirmed.

The Principal / Head of the Institution and other faculty members such as HODs / Sr. Lecturers / Lecturers should be appointed on regular basis and should possess minimum qualification and experience as prescribed by AICTE. No faculty members should be appointed and engaged as regular faculty unless having fulfilled meeting the AICTE minimum norms of qualification and experience etc.., and confirmed.

All the faculty members including the principal, head of the Institution should be selected and placed as per the regular selection procedures, such as, by constituting proper selection committees and following the open selection process. These appointments are required to be approved and regularised by the competent authorities and confirmed.

All faculty members recruited and placed under regular selection process should be Paid AICTE prescribed pay scales. Proper records and rolls of acquittance of their payments shall be maintained by the Institution, and the records of which shall be subjected to verification by competent authorities whenever called for.

Although the Institution can engage the services of part time / visiting faculty as only to the extent of what norms provide as contributing faculty, the same cannot be substituted against the regular full time faculty, Who should be appointed on permanent basis as per the minimum AICTE's norms and confirmed.

The total teaching faculty ratio with respect to various levels of faculty such as HOD/Sr Lectures / Lectures should be as nor minimum porms of the ALCTE and

WORKSHOP;

The workshop area / building should be as per minimum norms of AICTE with area and equipments.

The equipment provided in the workshop should be increased to avoid overcrowding of the students.

The workshops staff and non-teaching technical staff should be recruited and placed as per AICTE norms.

Proper lighting/ventilation and moving space should be provided for conducive work environment.

State of art and latest technological machines and equipment's as per AICTE norms.

LABORATORY:

All laboratories should be provided and fully established for various courses/disciplines by providing adequate space, furniture, equipments and reference materials, as per AICTE's minimum norms.

Each laboratory should be equipped with minimum set up equipments as per the requirements and the total investment on each laboratory shall be as per norms of AICTE.

All equipments in the laboratory should be properly documented and records for the same be maintained as stock registers in the respective laboratories with details of the cost, date of purchase and numbers. These records shall be made available for verification to the assessment committee, without fail whenever required.

LIBRARY:

The library area should be adequate to provide the minimum space requirements for reading room and stacking area.

The Institution should provide all important National and International Technical Journals Magazines and periodicals as per AICTE norms. Any shortage shall be immediately overcome by additional subscription and investment.

Adequate furniture should be provided in the reading hall as per AICTE norms for the ratio of the total students.

The library should be managed by qualified librarian and other supporting staff as per AICTE norms

The Institution should provide the minimum number of titles and books with annual additions as per AICTE norms in all the disciplines / courses.

FINANCIAL STANDING:

The Financial standings details such as Income and Expenditure statements and Balance sheet should be audited and furnished to the AICTE / WRO office or any other authorised expert by AICTE as and when called off.
