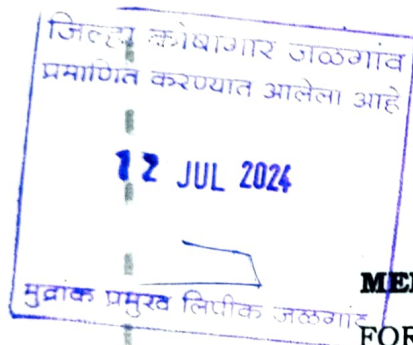

Godavari College Of Engineering , Jalgaon

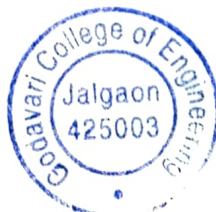

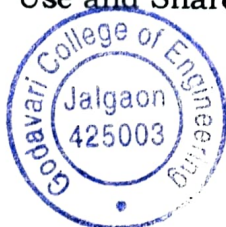
